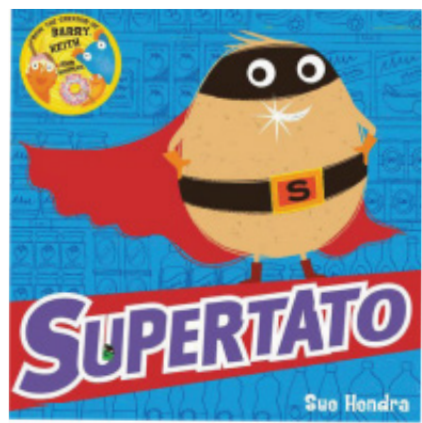

Make Your Own Supertato

Materials

- A potato
- Pipe cleaners
- Sweet wrappers / wool / felt / embellishments
- Felt-tip pens
- Fabric or tissue for cape
- Glue
- Googly eyes
- Scissors

Instructions

- Clean and dry the potato
- Stick on the googly eyes (or draw eyes on)
- Draw on mouth etc
- Cut the pipe cleaners up and with an adult's help push into the potato to make arms and legs
- Draw a superhero logo or name on the fabric /tissue and cut out a cape
- Glue the cape on to the potato
- Add any further decorations!
- Save the world with Supertato!
